Project 1 □ **Wewak Project, PNG** = *saving the women's space*

This project will assist the ministry of the Sisters as they provide a safe place for the women of the urban area. This place is a haven for the women to come to, to fish off the rocks, to sit and to relax with other women. Their women's space called - *Stella Maris* - is falling into the ocean thus the support we provide maintenance on the foundations.



Project 2 □ **Carmen Pampa Project, Bolivia** = *youth ministry*

This project will support the Pastoral Ministry Program the Sisters run. This program provides young people (ages 17-25) an opportunity to develop and strengthen their personal faith and relationship with God through a variety of activities, as well as gain leadership opportunities.

Project 3 □ **Cochuna Project, Bolivia** = *school farm*

This project will support a school farm expansion and set up a tree nursery in Cochuna, Bolivia. The support we provide will go towards resources that will allow the children to cultivate more vegetables and to reforest the land where the school and village are.



Project 4 Bello □ **Horizonte Project, Peru** = *ministry & the environment*

This desert area is vast and the needs are great. The Sisters minister to very poor communities in shanty towns. The Sisters are training local people to be able to minister to their own communities. Our support will allow them to buy bibles and seedlings for their community nursery. The area is pure desert & the need great.



Project 5 □ **USA/Haiti Project** = *family support*

This project will support extension work that sees the Sisters partner with Caritas in Haiti. Sr Marie mfc needs capital to allow her to co-ordinate the teams that went to Haiti by keeping in touch with them daily and with their families in the states.



Project 6 □ **Shekina Project, Peru** = *completing a building project for women*

This project will help to add a third floor to the Shekina building where the Sisters train women in sewing, crafts and cooking. Support is needed to purchase sewing machines, chairs, light bulbs, doors and floor tiles.



Project 7 □ **Sondor Project, Peru** = *hygiene*

This project aims to build a consciousness of good hygiene habits among the people by teaching them the importance of taking care of their health and the environment so that they can enjoy a better quality of life. The Sisters coordinate clean-ups, they recycle and make organic fertilizer for family gardens



Project 8 **Vivero Project, Peru** = *environment*

This project will support those who live in extreme poverty and are handicapped to work in a vivero (nursery). Our support will assist the Sisters to buy water, train the workers and give the entire community a sense of dignity.
